











This term we will be focussing our learning around three key texts: Storm Whale, Big, Blue Whale and The Snail and the Whale. We will begin the term by exploring and learning about the continents and oceans of the world. We will locate them on a map and we will use atlases and globes. In art we will be using a range of media to create sea-

scapes and sculptures. We will look at work by the artists Turner and Hokusai and we will compare their work. In ICT we will be learning how to use the features of PowerPoint and over the term we will be creating, saving and adding to our own presentations.



## Maths

We will begin with a recap of our calculation strategies for addition and subtraction. We will then look at counting in sets of 2s, 5s and 10s. We will explore the number patterns created from counting in steps and identify odd and even numbers. We will also begin to explore the operations of multiplication and division; identifying and using the

We will also begin to explore the operations of multiplication and division; identifying and using the signs in number sentences. We will explore sharing objects in to equals sets and creating multiple equal sets to help us calculate. Number sentences. Towards the end of this term we will introduce fractions. We will look at halves and quarters and identify fractions of shapes, objects and numbers.

#### Science

In Science we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will be comparing and sorting animals. We will look at the animals groups of mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish and birds and identifying features within these groups.
