

This term as we welcome the children back to school we have been learning all about our school values which we will incorporate into our lessons throughout the year. Going forward we will be exploring three key texts:

Journey and Quest written by Aaron Becker and Beekle written by Dan Santat. We will be exploring transport through history and looking at how the opening of Skegness Train Station in 1873 impacted upon the local area.

In design we will look at how to make models move and we will be making our own moving vehicles.

<u>Maths</u>

We will recap our learning from Year One and build on this. We will explore different strategies for addition and subtraction. We will look at partitioning numbers into tens and ones and using this to help us calculate number sentences.



We will be looking at ordering numbers and using the greater and less than symbols to make comparisons between numbers.

<u>Science</u>

In Science we will explore different materials. We will name and describe a range of materials and look at how the properties are related to their use. We will then use these materials to make our model vehicles.
