Dear Parents and carers,

As you are aware children in Year 2 are taking part in the SATS throughout May. These are assessments of your child and your child's teacher will use what they have seen in the classroom, as well as the results of these assessments, to help judge how well your child is progressing overall in maths, reading, writing and science. The combined results will also help teachers identify if your child needs further support moving into Year 3, and to put this in place as early as possible.

The children have worked extremely hard so far. Class teachers and the rest of the Academy staff are also working hard to support your child in order for them to achieve their potential at the end of KS1. In addition to the high quality teaching within the class, some of the interventions your child has had include-

- Use of additional adults in class across year 2 to reduce the ratio of children to adult support
- Reading booster sessions
- Maths booster sessions
- Access to after school support through club provision
- One to one support and working in small groups for focused, guided work when needed
- Homework set to support the work covered in class.
- Practice activities to ensure the children are 'question' ready.

We are hoping all the hard work will pay off soon giving your child the excellent start to the next phase of their learning journey.

We need your continued support in ensuring your child **attends school as much as possible**. If your child is not in school and misses a day of learning it is very difficult for them to make it up. Lateness can also cause disruptions. Therefore absences for any reason need to be kept to an absolute minimum from now until after the end of May. Can we request that you ensure they have a good night's rest throughout this period.

Breakfast will be provided and offered to all children. There are plenty of rewards and fun activities at this time too and children enjoy it!
