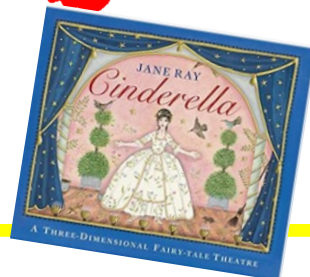




Telling Tales!

Year 1: Term 3 2024



This term we will be focussing our learning around Traditional Tales. We will focus on three key texts: Little Red Riding Hood, Little Red Hen and Cinderella. We will also be exploring a range of non-fiction texts to gather information to support our understanding of the characters and themes within the traditional tales.

In D&T we will be looking at where our food comes from, food hygiene and we will be working towards following recipes for making pancakes and bread.

Maths

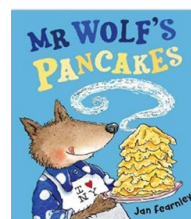


In Maths we will be focusing on number bonds to 20 by using practical strategies to recognise patterns and systematic approaches to problem solving. We will be learning about money and we will be looking at recognising coins and using the correct coins to pay for items. We will use our calculation knowledge to investigate how we can pay for items using different combinations of coins. We will also be learning about fractions and we will be finding fractions of shapes and numbers. We will continue to explore measures by looking at weight and capacity and the equipment that we use to for each. We will apply our skills in a practical context when we make our pancakes and bread.



English

Throughout the term we will be reading a variety of traditional tales. We will be using drama activities to retell them and we will be exploring a range of writing styles including recounts and instructions. We will be learning about verbs in our grammar lessons and we will be investigating new vocabulary used in our traditional tales. We will discuss the meaning of new words and we will try to include them in our own writing.



Science

In Science we will be focusing on...

- Seasonal change and winter. We will be completing a weather chart.
- Investigations including recording our findings and making predictions.
