Happy New Year to you all. We would like to welcome our new children and their families to Skylarks Nursery and look forward to working with you and your children over the coming year. This term we will be settling the children in and getting them used to the environment and being part of a group. We will focus on building relationships both with adults and their peers and begin to learn some daily routines.

Our topic this term is Where shall we go?

We will be looking at books about winter adventures. We will explore the outdoor environment and experience what the winter looks and feels like. We will be talking about where we can go to keep ourselves warm and be learning how to put our outdoor clothing on independently.

<u>Physical development</u>

This term we will be focusing on our gross motor skills. The children will have the opportunity to develop their skills on the bikes and scooters and to join in with balancing activities. They will also use chalks and other mark making materials to make large marks on the playground and chalkboards.

Speaking, listening and Phonics.

We will build on the children's confidence to talk to adults about what they want and express their needs.

We will also be encouraging the children to talk about what they see and feel during the wintertime. We will be listening to the sounds that they hear when walking on frost, ice or maybe even snow. We will join in the big bird watch and listen to the sounds that different birds make and use words to describe the birds that we see.
