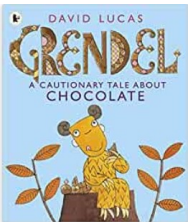


A World Apart

This term our focus will be on chocolate. We will investigate how chocolate is made and we will be making some delicious chocolate of our own. We will explore the packaging of existing products and how designers encourage people to buy their product. This will culminate in us designing our own packaging for our own chocolate. We will explore three key texts throughout the term: Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Grendel, a cautionary tale about chocolate and the poem, Chocolate Cake.



Maths

This term we will focus on measure with a practical focus on measuring length, mass and capacity. We will also look at positions using positional language by linking it to our



Geography skills.

We will continue to work on our calculation skills during daily Maths Blasts to ensure we are using the correct strategies for solving a range of problems.

Science

In Science we will explore plants. We will look at the life cycle of a range of plants and explore at the function of different plant parts. As part of science week we will set up a range of experiments investigating how plants respond to their environmental conditions.

English



This term we will be exploring the work of Roald Dahl and particularly his story, 'Charlie and the chocolate factory'.

We will explore the fantastic language he has used in his stories and we will use this to help us describe key characters from the story. We will be writing character descriptions for Charlie Bucket and Willy Wonka.

We will continue our work on punctuation and applying this to each sentence type-

Exclamation, statement, command and question.

We will also write diary entries linked to Grendel and we will write our own poems after reading Chocolate Cake.

We will continue to edit our own writing to make corrections, improvements and additions.
