Maths

Our focus this term is:

Counting larger amounts,

Consolidating our subitising skills,

Talking about how amounts are made such as 5 is 2 and

3,

Comparing amounts and measures such as length and capacity.

Reading and Writing

This term we will be working on letter formation and independent writing skills.

If your child does any writing at home please encourage them to sound and write the words on their own rather than copying your writing.

In phonics we will be consolidating phase 3 sounds (digraphs and trigraphs) and read longer words which contain them. We will also read words ending in -ing, -ed, and -est and learning lots of new tricky words
