## Phonics and Literacy

This term we are continuing to learn to recognise some letter sounds and hear them at the beginning of words.

Please continue to practise these at home by showing your child the letter, asking them to teach you the action and song and spotting things that begin with that sound. We are beginning to think about breaking up the sounds in words by using simple 3 letter words and hearing what sound is at the beginning, in the middle and at the end of them.

We are also recapping on rhyming using the Shark in the park series of books.



## Maths

Our focus this term is:  
Sharing an amount equally.

Using money in play

Combining 2 groups to add together.

Using objects to take away in play.
