## Year 2

Your child is now going to be in Year 2. It is a year in which your child will be experiencing many new and exciting things. This booklet is intended to inform you of some of the activities, procedures and entitlements which your child will experience during the year.

### Staffing

Class 10 Mrs Lewis-Bettison, supported by Mrs Houghton.

Class 11 Miss Stead, supported by Miss Pearce.

Mrs Chamberlain will also support across the year group.



### Swimming

Your child will participate in swimming as part of the PE curriculum. Children will need to bring a bag containing a school appropriate costume and towel. Also if they have long hair we ask that you provide a swimming cap. You will be informed of the dates for swimming nearer the time.

### End of year tests

We are working towards the end of key stage assessments. In May children will complete tests in Reading, Arithmetic and Mathematical Reasoning. Throughout the year we will build the skills necessary to be confident in these tests and use the results to inform teacher assessments. Further information sessions about the end of year expectations will take place next year.

## The school hours are: 9:00 am— 3:10pm

The school doors in Y2 playground open at 8:50 to enable all children to be in school and ready to learn at 9:00.

It is crucial that your child establishes a good attendance pattern, in order not to miss out on essential learning, both in their social and personal development and in their academic work.

### The end of the school day

The school day ends at 3.10pm and classroom doors will be open for parents to collect their children. If you are running late or cannot pick up, a password may be used to let another responsible adult collect your child.



### Homework

Each week your child will bring home their homework folder. We ask that you help your child practise these spellings and they also write the words into sentences. The homework is intended to support children's learning so we ask that it is completed as independently as possible and you support where needed.



### Reading crowns

Reading at home is very important and we will continue to encourage children to work hard to achieve their reading crowns by reading at home everyday.

### Spelling WASP—We are Spelling Perfectly

Each term children will be given a list of words to practise spelling at home. At the end of the term there will be class competition in the style of a Spelling Bee. The winners of the class competition will go through to the year group competition each term.
