Fabulous Phonics

This term we are focusing on developing the children's phonics skills.

The children will be learning the corresponding sound to each letter. They will then begin to blend these sounds together orally to say a word.

As a school we follow the Little Waddle phonics programme. More information will follow later this term.

Marvellous Maths

Our focus this term is:

Number: We will focus on children recognising, ordering and writing numbers and also counting groups of objects carefully.

Measure: We will learn to compare and order objects by size, weight and capacity.

Shape: We will learn about naming and describing 2d shapes such as square, triangle, rectangle and circle. We will also be exploring patterns.
