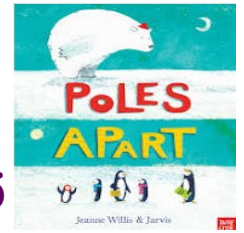


Where shall we go?

We will end with looking at the place where we live and comparing it to the other places that we have learned about.

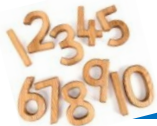
Maths

Our focus this term:

Number: We will focus on finding one more and one less, counting out amounts and subitising. We will be developing a deep understanding of numbers to 5. We will also practise writing numbers and representing combinations of amounts.

Measure: We will learn about comparing and ordering objects by weight, length, height and capacity.

Shape: We will name and describe 2d and 3d shapes. We will recognise and continue repeating patterns.

This term we will consolidate the sounds we have learned last term as well as learning the new sounds for term 2 which include some digraphs. We will continue to learn to blend to read 3 letter words and learn lots of new tricky words.

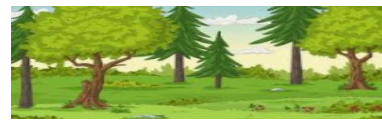
Phonic and reading parent information
