



# This is Me

## Year 1 Term 6 2026

This term we will be focussing our learning around three key texts: *Somebody Swallowed Stanley*, *Somebody Crushed Collin*, and *What A Waste!*. We will begin the term by looking at our locality and following maps to find a destination on the school grounds. We will then explore making our own maps in Geography. In Art we will be exploring making self portraits using different media and materials in different styles. We will be drawing our inspiration from various artists including Pablo Picasso, Jane Perkins-Briti and Alberto Giacometti. In ICT we will be learning how to use the paint programme and exploring how to use the tools. We will also compare computer art and painting.



### Maths

We will begin with a recap of our calculation strategies for addition and subtraction. We will be taking part in active maths in our outdoor environment to consolidate our learning. We will then look at telling the time to the hour and half past the hour. We will explore position, direction and movement and will link this to our learning in Geography. We will also begin to exploring number stories and estimating on a number line. Towards the end of this term we will be exploring shape.



### English

Throughout the term we will be using drama activities to retell stories and help us to better understand the characters from our key texts. We will be exploring a range of writing styles including writing a story ending, information leaflet, explanation text and letter to the principal. Our Author of the Term is Sarah Roberts. We will be using her book, *Somebody Swallowed Stanley* and *Somebody Crunched Collin* as a starting point for our own writing.

### Grammar, spelling and punctuation

We will continue to look at suffixes -es, -s and the prefix -un in our grammar lessons and each week we will be investigating new vocabulary. We will discuss the meaning of new words and we will try to include them in our own writing. We will continue to explore the use of phonics to aid reading and spelling within our writing.

### Science

In Science we will continue our learning on animals including humans. We will be identifying and labelling parts of the body as well as exploring and learning about the 5 senses and taking part in experiments.
