## Year 2 Term 6 2026

This term we will be focussing our learning around our locality, with a particular focus on the seaside. We will learn about the history of the circus and we will begin the term by looking at different historical sources and discussing the reliability of sources. We will then use some of these sources to find out about Philip Astley, who developed the first British circus. We will be creating our own maps in Geography and using key symbols to add detail. In D&T we will be designing and making our own acrobat swings and then we will be exploring how to make our structures stronger. In ICT we will be exploring the use of technology for programming.

### Maths

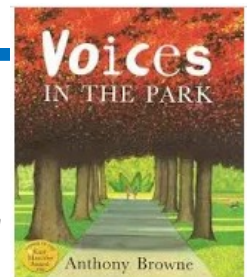
We will begin with a recap of the strategies used for problem solving and we will be solving a range of maths problems involving money, shape, fractions and measure including time. We will be using our outdoor area during our maths lessons to complete a range of active challenges, to consolidate our skills in counting in different step sizes and in gathering data. We will be developing our reasoning skills and we will explore problems that are sometimes true, always true or never true and we will be explaining how we know. We will be showing a range of working out, using the strategies from throughout the year to support our answers.



### English

We will be exploring texts written by Anthony Browne.

We will have a particular focus on the book, 'Voices in the Park', which explores the same walk through the park from four different view points. We will be learning about the features of a book review and then writing our own based on the text.



### Science

In Science we will be learning about habitats from around the world. We will explore the Arctic, desert habitats and rainforests. We will make comparisons to what we already know about habitats in our locality.

### Grammar, spelling and punctuation

We will continue to look at spelling patterns and rules for adding a range of suffixes.
