Noticing number patterns

Addition and number bonds within 10

Counting

This term we will continue to work on letter formation and independent writing skills. We will be writing in sentences and using capital letters and full stops.

In reading we will be looking at phase 4 words with long vowel sounds. We will read words with word endings such as s, es, ing, ed, er, est.

Reading at Home

Please encourage your child to read at home at least 4 times a week and let your child's teacher know. If your child reads at least 4 times they will get to wear a reading crown on a Friday and be rewarded with dojo points.
