



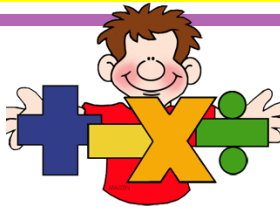
Celebrations around the World

Year 2: Term 2 2018

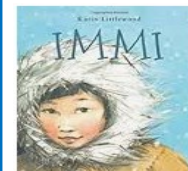
