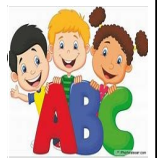


Class Attendance Winner

Flu Vaccinations

Just a reminder that children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be having the flu vaccination next Tuesday. The flu vaccination provides protection against the flu strains that are predicted to circulate each year. These strains may be different from last year which is why it is recommended to have a vaccination every year. The vaccination is administered by a very simple nasal spray by the School Nurse.



Attendance

May we remind parent/carers that should your child be absent from school for more than 4 days we require to see medical evidence at the office. As well as telephoning the office when your child is absent, you can send a text message to the school mobile on 07738 755727. If your child is late 4 or more times in a single term, or your child's attendance falls below 90% then parent/carers will be invited into school for a School Attendance Panel (SAP) meeting. Attendance certificates will be given out soon to children with 100% attendance, children who always attend school on time and children who have improved attendance. There is also some exciting news coming up about attendance - watch this space!
