Uniform

Pupils in Y3 – Y5 are not required to wear a button up shirt and tie. They will require a plain white polo shirt to go underneath their Academy Jumper/Cardigan. Academy jumpers and cardigans can be ordered from our new uniform supplier Nationwide. Details for ordering online will be forwarded as soon as the new website is completed. For P.E. pupils will need a purple polo shirt and a pair of plain black shorts.

On transfer from the Infant to the Junior Academy, we are pleased to be able to provide our new intake with the following items free of charge:

One Academy Book Bag

One Academy Water Bottle

These items will be distributed to pupils during the first two weeks of term.

Lunches

Lunch menus for the first week back in September will be sent out to you via mail in the next week or so with instruction on payment methods. These will need to be returned by **Monday 13th July** as meals need to be booked before for the start of the school holidays.

If you received free school meals at Skegness Infant Academy, you need to reapply here <https://www.lincolnshire.gov.uk/school-pupil-support/apply-free-school-meals> to check your continuing eligibility. We will also require a form completing with meal choices from the menu. Not completing these forms could result in your child not receiving the correct funding for the meals and additional educational support in school they may be entitled to. **Please note: According to Government guidelines, on transfer to the Junior Academy we will only be able to provide free lunches for those children whose parents are in receipt of the qualifying benefits. Not all pupils transferring to the Junior Academy will be eligible for free school meals.**

Admission Forms

We will be sending out our school admission forms for completion online. Please complete and return these to the Junior Academy as soon as possible before Friday 17th July in order for us to process all the details we need to.

The first day of the new term will be **Wednesday 2nd September 2020.**
