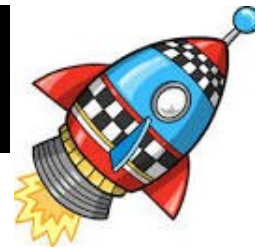


To infinity and Beyond
